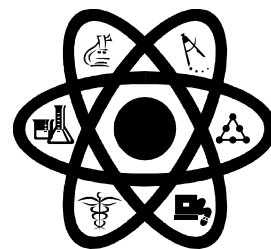

<b>Junior Division (Grades 6-8):</b> <b>Attach a Project Summary</b>	Attach <b>three typed copies</b> of a one-page project summary (abstract) along with the registration form and fee. Group projects need to submit only one set of three copies of the project summary. The project summary must be typed (single spaced, Times New Roman, 12 point) and include the following information: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Project Title, Name of Student(s), Name of School, Grade, Category</li><li>• Summarize principal hypotheses, methods and materials, and conclusions.</li></ul> Project summaries received after the deadline will not receive a full score and may not be accepted for judging.
<b>Senior Division (Grades 9-12):</b> <b>Submit a Project Report</b>	Submit <b>two typed copies</b> of the full report along with the registration form and fee. The Project Report must be typed (single spaced, Times New Roman, 12 point, preferred). It must consist of the following sections, preferably in the order listed below. Pages should be numbered sequentially using Arabic numerals. Proper credit must be given where others' work is used or referred to. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Title Page, including project title, your name, school, and grade</li><li>• Hypothesis or Statement of Purpose</li><li>• Procedure, including material list</li><li>• Discussion/Conclusions/Applications, including supporting data, tables, graphs, pictures, and/or other documentation</li><li>• References/Bibliography</li></ul> Project reports received after the deadline will not receive a full score and may not be accepted for judging.
